



Mobile Eyes and Healthy Eyes Criteria

Mobile Eyes

Mobile Eyes is a program that is available to assist adults with the cost of an eye exam and glasses if needed. To qualify, the following criteria must be met:

- Family income is at or below 200% of poverty level
- Is not covered by Medicaid or any other vision insurance
- Is a U.S. citizen or documented immigrant with social security number
- Has not used a voucher during the last 12 months

Healthy Eyes

Healthy Eyes Eyeglass Program is a program available to children and adults and covers the cost of eye glasses only. To qualify, the following criteria must be met:

- Family income is at or below 200% of poverty
- Do not have any other eyeglass benefits they can access
- Have a valid eyeglass prescription that is one year old or less
- Have participated in a Prevent Blindness screening program or have been referred by a Prevent Blindness partner agency
- Have not previously participated in this program (unless there has been a change in their prescription or their eyeglasses have been damaged beyond repair)

The Healthy Eyes Eyeglass Program can only be used at Lens Crafters, Sears Optical, Target Optical or Pearle Vision.
