

INTRODUCING THE GAME For 3K, 4K, and 5K only

Dear Teachers,

Before your vision screening, it is important that you:

- Explain and practice the game with the children one week before your screening.
- Approach the activity as a GAME, <u>not</u> a test.

The Picture Game

- 1. To play, the child simply names the pictures they are shown.
- 2. Together with the children, decide what to call the pictures. You might pick: SQUARE HOUSE APPLE BALL
- 3. Give each child a turn to tell you the name of each picture.
- 4. Explain that the screener will gently cover one eye at a time with a pair of glasses so that each eye gets to play the game alone.

NOTE: During the screening, children who are shy or hesitant can <u>point</u> to a matching picture.
